3 How to apply

During the application period, send an application form to the HIA office by fax or email. The application form can be found at the HIA office or on the HIA website.

※We will contact you after we have received your application.

Please contact us if you did not receive any information by the placement test dates.

4 Maximum number of students

Approximately 20 students per class.
(Students will be selected by lottery if we receive too many applications.)

5 Tuition

2,000 yen per term.

※You must also pay for your textbook.

※Please pay on the first day of class.

※We cannot refund tuition for any reason whatsoever.

6 Placement test

You are required to take the placement test.

1st	Mon, April 18 th or Tues, April 19 th
2nd	Tues, Sept 20 th or Fri, Sept 23 th

※Tests are held at 10 AM, 2 PM, and 5 PM for 1 hour each.

※There will be no Children's class this financial year.
