

### **Please Call Us First to Consult with Us by Phone if You Have a Fever, Etc.**

In this prefecture, we have taken the appropriate measures to prepare a consultation/examination/testing program through which prefectural residents can be examined at local medical institutions (medical institutions equipped to perform examinations/testing for individuals exhibiting fevers, etc.) where we have put in place the proper systems needed to perform examination/testing for any individuals who are suspected of having contracted the novel coronavirus or influenza, etc., due to exhibiting symptoms, such as a fever, etc.

#### **■ Please Consult with Us by Phone/Make a Reservation to Be Examined**

○ If you have a fever, etc., we ask that you first call your local medical institution (primary care doctor, etc.) and consult with them by phone.

○ If you do not have a primary care doctor, etc., and you are unsure of where to call to consult, please consult with the “Examination/Consultation Centers for Individuals Exhibiting Fevers, Etc.” (Health and Welfare Offices/Public Health Centers, etc.) or the “Novel Coronavirus Health Consultation Call Center” (Please see the reverse side of this flyer; you can also find guidance information on the prefectural government’s website).

○ Please refrain from directly going to these medical institutions to get examined without calling them first.

#### **■ What Are “Medical Institutions Equipped to Perform Examinations/Testing for Individuals Exhibiting Fevers, Etc.?”**

○ These are medical institutions that have implemented measures to prevent any further on-premises spreading of diseases, and visitors will be able to enjoy peace of mind while being examined.

#### **■ Precautions When Visiting for an Examination**

○ When coming in to be examined, please make sure to always wear a mask and follow any instructions given by the medical institution.

○ Please refrain from using public transit when visiting the medical institution.

#### **■ About Proper Medical Examinations**

○ Since there is a risk that your symptoms may worsen if you go to extreme lengths to avoid being examined, we ask that individuals that have preexisting conditions or are feeling unwell to first consult with their primary care doctor.
